

Short Bio

James N. Kiarie is an Associate Professor in Obstetrics and Gynaecology at the University of Nairobi, and a Consultant Obstetrician Gynaecologist in Kenyatta National Hospital. He is an affiliate Associate Professor in Epidemiology and Global Health at the University of Washington. His work focuses on HIV/AIDS, reproductive health, Health Professionals training, mentorship and use of Information technologies in research and training.

Prof Kiarie leads the University of Nairobi Partnership in Innovative Medical Education for Kenya (PRIME-Kenya) project. He also directs the University of Nairobi HIV Capacity Building Fellowship Program that supports the Kenyan National HIV AIDS response by training program managers and leaders. He has over 100 peer reviewed papers in international journals and is currently the PI of a community based cohort study on HIV infection risk and pregnancy intention that is enrolling couples Western Kenya
